Essay Review

- Always introduce your quotes by establishing the context of the quote.
- Never give details away in the introduction.
- NEVER quote a source in the introduction
- ALWAYS introduce the author and the title of the work your are discussing.
- Topic sentences state the central idea of a paragraph and limit the context. It's usually the first sentence of the paragraph.
- Always use present tense when referring to a source.



MLA Review

- Check your margins and line spacing.
- **DO NOT use ellipses** unless you are using them correctly (MLA). If you use them and they are incorrect, your grade will suffer.
